We know many of you are concerned about the spread of COVID-19 (the new coronavirus) and how it may impact us here at Sodalis Senior Living. Sodalis will help facilitate those communications smart devices in our communities and guides to facilitate virtual communications and social connectedness.

Please also make sure we have your most current, emergency contact information. We want to efficiently communicate with you should there be any new developments. Please reach out to your local community with your updated contact information.

Residents, please help prevent the spread of infection by exercising proper hand washing hygiene as well as coughing and sneezing etiquette. We offer hand washing and alcohol-based hand sanitizer stations throughout each community, which you are welcome to use. Please also avoid shaking hands and hugs with any individual. If you are experiencing a cough, fever, sore throat, runny nose, and/or shortness of breath, please let a staff member know immediately.
